To apply for Federal Financial Aid, complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) for 2023-2024 at studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa and the Delaware Law Data Form at delawarelaw.widener.edu/dataform. As a graduate student, you will complete the FAFSA with your (& spouse's) 2021 tax information. A Financial Aid Checklist has been included for your review. → Finalize Your Enrollment:

Submit your non-refundable \$400 seat deposit to secure your place in the fall entering class at Delaware Law. Please submit your seat deposit online at <http://widener.edu/marketplace>. Your acceptance is conditioned upon receipt by the Law School of an official transcript showing successful completion of your undergraduate studies and the award of your baccalaureate degree. You **MUST** submit your final official transcript showing the award of your baccalaureate degree to the Law School Admission Council (LSAC) by **August 1st**.

→ Review the COVID-19 Vaccination Policy:

Widener University **requires** that all faculty, staff, and students on all campuses, including the Delaware Law School campus, receive their COVID-19 vaccination prior to enrollment. Proof of full COVID-19 vaccination must be submitted electronically through the student health portal by **August 1st**.
