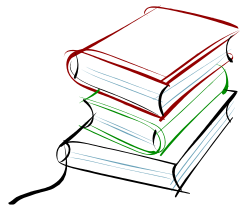

The Cost of Attendance provides for an approximate monthly living expense budget of \$2,439 for a student living off-campus after paying for books, tuition and fees.
