	Submit Your Final Transcript → Your acceptance is conditioned upon our receipt of an official transcript showing successful completion of your undergraduate studies, including the date of conferral. You MUST submit your final official transcript to the Law School Admission Council (LSAC) by August 1st.
	Submit Required Records → The State of Delaware also requires evidence of immunity to Measles, Mumps and Rubella prior to your matriculation. Proof of immunity MUST be submitted electronically, via upload to your Applicant Status Online (ASO) under the "Documents" heading, by August 1st.
