ORDER

This 6th day of April, 2020, it appears to the Supreme Court of Delaware that:

WHEREAS, Continuing Legal Education Rule 4 provides that at least 12 of the required 24 CLE credit hours that shall be completed during each two-year period must be earned by attending in person, live CLE approved courses;

WHEREAS, in person, live CLE approved courses have been cancelled due to the COVID-19 crisis; and

WHEREAS, due to the cancellation of in person, live CLE approved courses, and to uncertainty as to when they may resume, it is desirable to waive the requirement that in person, live CLE approved courses make up at least 12 of the required hours for the two year periods ending December 31, 2020 and December 31, 2021.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED as follows:

1. The requirement that at least 12 of the 24 CLE credit hours must be earned by attending in person, live CLE approved courses is waived for the two year periods ending December 31, 2020 and December 31, 2021. All 24 CLE credit hours for those two-year periods may be satisfied by approved courses that do not require an in-person, live appearance.
